Sir.

Kindly refer to the approval of the cabinet circulated vide letter No. /P&DD/Admin/ 7778-7830/2009 September 15, 2009 and subsequently Govt. Notification issued vide No. P&D/Gen/1575-1675/2011 dated 11-3-2011, regarding the enforcement of AJK Interim Composite Schedule of Rates (ICSR) applicable to all ten districts for development activities. As there is a rapid fluctuation of market prices, the AJK-ICSR needs its continuous updation on quarterly basis as practiced in Punjab to make the item rates of works compatible with the market. These updated rates are framed / calculated for Districts Headquarters (within Municipal limits) and now uploaded for application in estimation of the development projects for the current quarter, whereas for the adjoining areas carriage of materials may be added as per procedure laid down in Sec-1 of AJK-ICSR-2009.

Construction material sources/ quarries of district M.abad, Bagh, Hattain Bala, Kahuta (Havali), Kolti, Mirpur and Bhimber (As identified by the consultant M/S NESPAK) are also annexed with the updated AJK ICSR of respective district for quick reference to facilitate the user.
